

Traquair House & Peebles –Monday 5th May



Scotland's Oldest Inhabited House has been visited by 27 Scottish Kings and Queens and dates back to 1107. It has been lived in by the Stuart family since 1491.

Originally a royal hunting lodge, Traquair played host to Mary Queen of Scots and later as staunch Catholics they supported the Jacobite cause without counting the cost.

Peebles is a delightful market town which has won multiple awards for the range of shops and cafes on its High Street.

We will leave Castle Douglas (Market Hill car park) at 8.30 am, with a short stop then arrive at Traquair House & Gardens about 11.00 pm.

Leaving at 4.30 we would expect to be back in Castle Douglas by 7.00.

The cost is £35 to include the coach fee of £20 and £15 entrance fee.
